The Road to Reproductive Justice

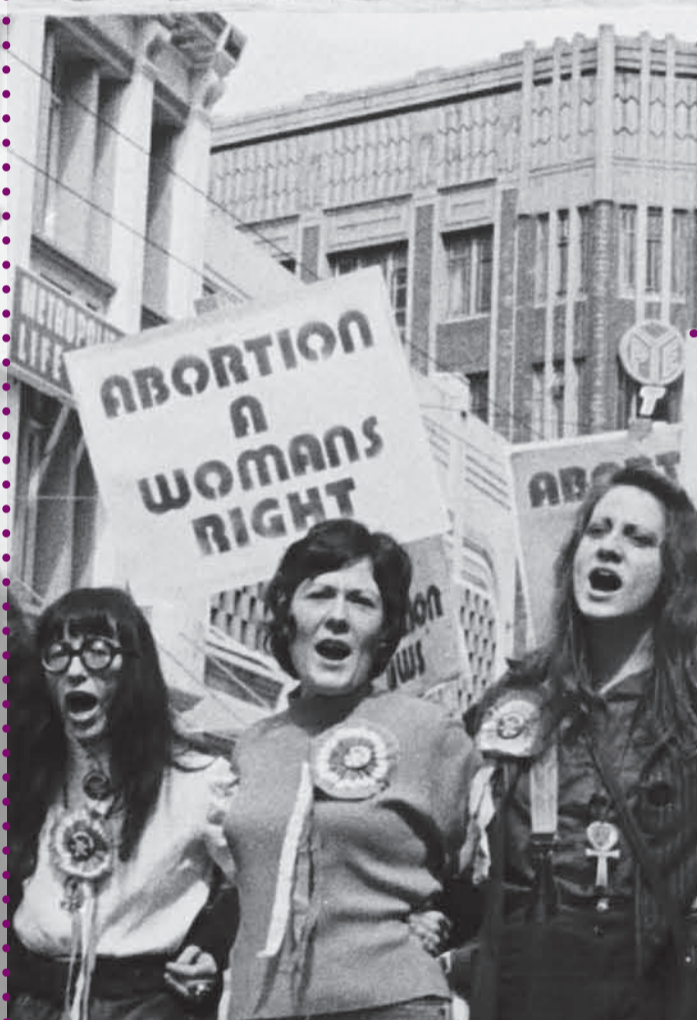
